# **Privacy Policy**

Hark Financial Planning, LLC ("HFP") recognizes that our relationships with current and prospective clients are based on integrity and trust. We work hard to maintain your privacy and to preserve the private nature of our relationship with you. We place the highest value on the information you share with us. HFP will not disclose your personal information to anyone unless it is required by law or at your direction. We will not sell your personal information.

We want our clients to understand what information we collect, how we use it, and how we protect your personal information.

#### Why We Collect Your Information

We gather information about you so that we can:

- Help design and implement the investment and financial planning related services we provide you; and
- Comply with the Federal and State laws and regulations that govern us.

#### What Information We Collect and Maintain

We may collect the following types of "nonpublic personal information" ("NPI") about you:

- Information from our initial meeting or subsequent consultations about your identity, such as your name, address, social security number, date of birth, and financial information;
- Information that we generate to service your financial needs; and
- Information that we may receive from third parties in connection with the services we provide you.

### What Information We Disclose

We are permitted by law to disclose nonpublic information about you to unaffiliated third parties in certain circumstances. HFP may disclose client's NPI: (1) to individuals and/or entities not affiliated with HFP, including, but not limited to, third-parties that assist in the supervision or management of your account(s) (i.e. account custodian, record keeper, attorney, etc.); (2) to service providers contracted by us for everyday business purposes in order for us to perform the duties of your engagement with HFP (i.e. client management systems, archiving technology vendors, cloud service providers, etc.); (3) to your authorized representative or power of attorney; (4) when we receive your prior consent; (5) as otherwise permitted to do so in accordance with the parameters of applicable federal and/or state privacy regulations. If we do not receive permission to share this NPI, then we are prohibited from sharing this NPI with unaffiliated third parties.

In the event that HFP has a change to its client privacy policy that would allow it to disclose NPI not covered under applicable law, HFP will allow its clients the opportunity to opt-out of such disclosure.
